Born 1/4/20 (*that's 1920*)

First year in hockey 1936 in B1 our third team (*so aged 16, no junior games or Minkey*).

Played for 59 seasons for a total of 863 games club highest until passed by Peter Willett (*this excluded 4 years on War Service*)

Last year 2001 in the over 50's (*went on to play at Subs, no over 60's then*)

Wife's name Dulcie (dec)

Peter was the 23<sup>rd</sup> member to play first division for the club.

Played 175 first division games for the club.

Played first division from 1938 till 1958 (*from ages 18 to 38*)

Missed years 1941 till 1945 during the war (*WW2*)

106<sup>th</sup> player for Australia when he played against New Zealand in 1948

Played many games of hockey in the war years in Queensland and North Africa with his brothers.

President of OAHC 1954 to 1956 and 1961 till 1966 (*a total of 9 years*)

Life member 1962

Passed away 28/8/2017

Aged 97
