
Junior Report

Performance Pathway Players (Triple P) Programme

After a review of the 2018 season, looking particularly at juniors who are involved in senior selected teams or state teams, with additional commitments outside of hockey (oh and also perhaps school work!). The Junior committee have put forward the idea of managing the training load of such junior players on an invitational basis. Newly involved junior developer, Ben Wright, has taken on the role of managing and developing this programme.

So... What is it?

The idea is to manage our junior players who have 2 or more hockey commitments, where one includes playing in the selected Men's or Women's grade, the other









commitment could include school, club juniors or state team representation.

What do they get out of it?

An opportunity to speak and manage workload with Ben, talk through priority areas of their week and try to align coaching relationships between various other stakeholders to accommodate for training/playing commitments whilst keeping on top of all other commitments outside of Reds Hockey.

Players will be invited based on their current senior grade (Men's and Women's 3s or above) where formal 1-1s will take place both off pitch and on pitch development.

Ben initial reaction to the launch of the Performance Pathway Players:

"The PPP programme is a useful tool to help de-stress players (and parents!) to help collaborate relationships across their weeks and to ensure that there is a balance between quality of training and adequate rest. As we are only targeting a few players currently, as this develops, I hope the programme is something


Team Reports






